HERE ARE THE FACTS:

Should I pay my rent?

Yes, your rent is still due. It has not been cancelled. If you cannot pay your rent or mortgage right now, you will not be evicted right now. But all your rent is still due, and eviction may start when the ban is lifted if you have not caught up on your rent.

Can I get more help with food?

Yes. You can still apply for SNAP or for WIC benefits. Both programs can help provide healthy food for your family. Apply online.

What about my RG&E bill?

The HEAP program can help you pay for heat and electricity. Apply online.

How about cash assistance?

You can get temporary cash assistance. Call 585-396-4433 or 315-789-1767 for information.

Can I get health insurance?

Yes. If you don't have health insurance or lost your job, Medicaid and the CHIP program for kids are both open. Apply online.

Can I get help paying for childcare?

Yes. You can apply now for help paying for daycare. Call 315-789-1767 for information.

I need help with mental health or substance abuse. Where do I go?

I need help applying for benefits.
