<i>Other Updates</i>	Sheriff Cirencione let the committee know that they have completed flooring improvements to the lobby and visitation area at the jail. The visitation area now has carpet for the first time. This has made the area more welcoming and has helped with noise reduction. With all the rain that arrived over the weekend, a lot of debris has entered Canandaigua Lake. He has issued a temporary reduced speed limit of 25 mph for the lake.
