SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT:

The purpose of this local law is to modify voting weights of the individual members of the Ontario County Board of Supervisors to reflect the results of the 2010 Federal census.

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY:

This local law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph thirteen of paragraph a of subdivision one of section ten of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
