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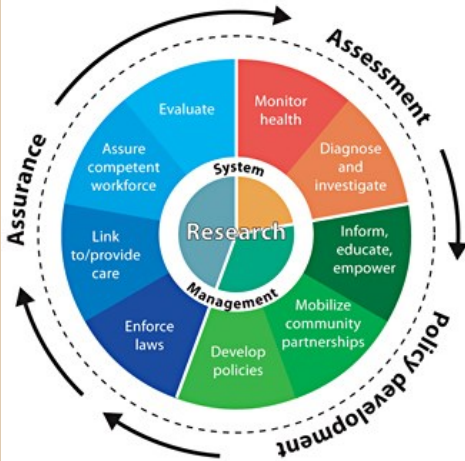

Essential Services

In Public Health there are ten Essential Public Health Services. Ontario County Public Health monitors the community's health status to identify, investigate and prevent health problems (diseases, injuries, etc.). We are focused on the prevention of illness and injury and the promotion of health equity (equality). We do this by informing, educating and empowering people about health issues.

The Role of Public Health

Ontario County Public Health collaborates with members of the community, medical providers, local hospitals, neighboring health departments, the New York State Department of Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to inform, educate and lessen the impact of health disparities in the Finger Lakes.

What does Public Health do for you?

- ◆ Provides education on smoking cessation, heart disease, diabetes, and other health topics.
- ◆ Promotes employee health by assisting with the development, and implementation of worksite wellness and lactation policies.
- ◆ Paves the way for healthy living through partnerships and coalitions like: Finger Lakes Breast Feeding Partnership and Ontario County Health Collaborative.
- ◆ Accesses and evaluates local health data from resources like the Finger Lakes Hypertension Registry.
